## **Instructions for Reporting Outside Scholarships**

It is important to report all sources of external funding so that we can update your financial aid accordingly. We try to allocate outside scholarships in such a way as to mitigate as much as possible any changes to your financial aid eligibility; however, it is possible your financial aid will change as a result of receiving external aid.

To report outside scholarships:

- 1. Log into your STAR self-service portal.
- 2. Click on the Student Center tile.
- 3. Under the Finances heading, click on View Financial Aid:



- 4. Select the 2025 Aid Year.
- 5. On the Award Summary screen, click on Report Other Financial Aid:

6. On the Aid from Other Sources screen, click on *Report Additional Aid*:
