3. Have an admissions interview by December 28, 2007
4. Submit the CSS Profile and FAFSA forms by February 1, 2008
5. Answer **one** of the following questions in 500 words or less and submit on a separate sheet of paper:
 - One of the various taglines that describes Worcester's ongoing revitalization and development states that Worcester is "The city on the move." With the lens of a Worcester resident, describe one direction in which you would like these development projects to take Worcester.
 - There are different sides of Worcester and those who are not familiar with the city have various differing impressions of it. How would you describe Worcester and "sell" the city to someone who is not familiar with the city?
