

TAILGATING POLICY

Our aim in enforcing this policy is to curtail excessive drinking — with special attention to underage students — while maintaining our tradition of Crusader camaraderie and fellowship. We thank you for your support of these policies.

1. Football tickets will be required in order to park on Freshman Field. (Tickets can be purchased when entering Freshman Field.)
2. Freshman Field and the baseball field will be open for tailgating three hours prior to kickoff.
3. No kegs or other common-source large quantities of alcohol will be allowed at any time.
4. For the safety of the athletic teams that use Freshman Field, please minimize the use of glass containers. If you do bring glass bottles, please dispose of the empty containers properly.
5. At game time, both fields will be cleared by Public Safety and the Worcester Police Department. Individuals will be asked to enter the stadium or will be asked to exit the premises.
6. No individual will be permitted to exit the stadium and linger on Freshman Field during the game (including half-time). The baseball field will be open during half-time, allowing fans to enjoy the “Interactive Endzone” area.
7. Full tailgating (setting up of grills, tables, etc.) will not be allowed on either field after the game. Individuals will be allowed to mingle/wind down with each other and leisurely leave the area. All fields will be cleared within one hour after the end of the game.

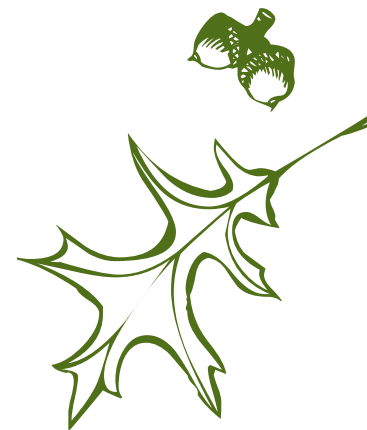
