Installing DreamWeaver MX 2004

1. In the Novell Application Launcher (NAL) window double click the **DreamWeaver MX 2004** icon
 - You can open the NAL by clicking **Start** | clicking **Run** | typing **nalwin32** in the box | clicking **OK**
2. Click **Yes** to begin the install (this will take several minutes)
 - Click **Yes** is you are asked to reboot.

Setting-Up DreamWeaver MX 2004

3. Open **DreamWeaver MX 2004** (see step 1)
4. On the **Edit** menu, select **Preferences**
5. In the Preferences window, click on the **Site** category in the left hand column.
6. Click the **Manage Sites** button (if no sites are listed continue to the next step, if there are sites listed go to step 10)
7. Click **New**, select **FTP & RDS Server**
8. Click **OK**
9. Enter the following information for the site you are trying to access (there are only 4 examples of the possible sites that could be added), then continue to step 12

12. Enter your login name in the Login box
13. Enter your password in the Password box
 - It is recommended against checking the Save box, since this would allow anyone using your computer to upload to the FTP server as you without needing your password.
14. Put a check in the **Use Secure FTP** box
15. Click **OK**
16. DreamWeaver will validate the server.
17. Click **OK** to close the Preference window.
