Day 1 Thursday, May 14, 2026: Departure from the US

- Depart from Boston Logan International Airport (**BOS**) to Oslo Airport (**OSL**).

Day 2 Friday, May 15, 2026: Oslo Arrival (D)

- **Guided City Tour of Oslo I:** Introduction to Norway's capital, featuring sights of Oslo's highlights such as **Holmenkollen Ski Jump**, an internationally renowned ski arena offering panoramic city views, and **Vigeland Park**, the world's largest sculpture park by a single artist, famous for its striking bronze and granite works.
- Check in to your hotel and enjoy a **welcome drink** as you decompress from today's activities.
- **Welcome Dinner** at a nearby restaurant in the evening.
- Overnight in **Oslo: Radisson Blu Plaza Hotel** or similar.

Day 3 Saturday, May 16, 2026: Oslo (B)

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- **Guided City Tour of Oslo II:** See cultural and political landmarks including the **City Hall**, **National Theater**, **Parliament**, **Royal Palace**, and **Oslo Cathedral**, each showcasing the city's heritage and architecture.
- **Nobel Peace Center:** End the tour in this museum dedicated to Nobel Peace Prize laureates, featuring interactive exhibits on peace and conflict resolution.
- Free time on your own at Aker Brygge waterfront.
- **Munch Museum:** Visit the home of Edvard Munch's masterpieces, including "The Scream," one of the world's most iconic paintings.

Day 4 Sunday, May 17, 2026: Oslo – Örebro – Stockholm (B, L, D)

- Breakfast at the hotel and check out.
- Scenic coach journey to **Stockholm**.
- Stop in **Örebro:** Enjoy a walk in the city center and admire **Örebro Castle**, a medieval fortress on an island in the Svartån River, notable for its imposing towers and centuries of history.
- Lunch included at **Skybar Svampen:** A unique restaurant inside a mushroom-shaped water tower, with sweeping city views and a signature mushroom soup.
- Continue to **Stockholm** for hotel check-in and **group dinner**.
- Overnight in **Stockholm: Clarion Hotel** or similar.

Day 5 Monday, May 18, 2026: Stockholm (B)

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- **Guided City Tour of Stockholm:** Discover **Gamla Stan (Old Town)**, a medieval district with cobblestone streets and colorful merchant houses. Highlights include the **Royal Palace**, official residence of Sweden's monarch; **Riddarhuset (House of Nobility)**, symbol of aristocratic heritage; and **Storkyrkan (Cathedral)**, a 13th-century Gothic church rich with art and history.
- **Royal Palace:** Tour the grand rooms and museums within one of Europe's largest palaces.

Day 6 Tuesday, May 19, 2026: Stockholm – Night Ferry to Finland (B, D)

- Breakfast and hotel check out.
- **Vasa Museum:** Visit the exhibition of a nearly fully preserved 17th-century warship that sank on its maiden voyage, offering a rare glimpse into naval history.
- Visit to the **Skansen Open-Air Museum:** Outdoor museum showcasing traditional Swedish life, crafts, and architecture.
- Evening boarding of **cruise to Finland**.
- Dinner buffet onboard.
- Overnight in private ferry cabin with en-suite facilities: **Viking line** or similar.

Day 7 Wednesday, May 20, 2026: Turku – Porvoo – Helsinki (B, D)

- Breakfast onboard before arrival in **Turku**, Finland's oldest city, founded in the 1200s.
- **Guided Tour of Turku:** Explore Finland's medieval past, including Turku Cathedral, the country's national shrine and most important religious building.
- **Drive to Porvoo:** Known for its colorful wooden houses, artisan shops, and riverside charm.
- **Guided Tour of Porvoo:** Learn about its well-preserved heritage and role in Finnish history.
- Continue to **Helsinki** for check-in and **group dinner**.
- Overnight in **Helsinki:** **Sokos Hotel Presidentti** or similar.

Day 8 Thursday, May 21, 2026: Helsinki (B, D)

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- **Guided City Tour of Helsinki:** See highlights including **Sibelius Monument**, dedicated to the famed composer; **Finlandia Hall**, a modernist masterpiece by Alvar Aalto; **Senate Square**, the neoclassical heart of the city; **Olympic Stadium**, host of the 1952 Summer Games; and **Uspenski Cathedral**, the largest Orthodox church in Western Europe.
- Afternoon free for individual exploration.
- **Farewell Dinner** at a traditional restaurant in the city center.

Day 9 Friday, May 22, 2026: Return to the US (B)

- Breakfast or breakfast box.
- Transfer to Helsinki-Vantaa Airport (HEL) for return flight.
