Day 2 Friday, October 16, 2026: Madrid - Arrival (D)

Day 5 Monday, October 19, 2026: Madrid - Granada (B, L, D)

- Breakfast at the hotel and check out.
- **Visit to a Vineyard and Winery:** Tour the grounds, learn about winemaking traditions, and enjoy a regional lunch paired with local wines.
- Continue to **Granada** for hotel check-in.
- **Dinner with Flamenco Show:** Experience authentic Andalusian cuisine while watching an expressive flamenco performance in a historic bullring setting.
- Overnight in **Granada: Hotel Eurostars San Anton or similar.**

Day 6 Tuesday, October 20, 2026: Granada (B)

- Breakfast at the hotel and check out.
- **Visit to Olive Oil Factory:** Learn about extra virgin olive oil production, from grove to press, with tastings of Spain's "liquid gold."
- **Visit to Alhambra Palace and Generalife Gardens:** UNESCO World Heritage site showcasing Moorish artistry, intricate palaces, and lush gardens with spectacular views of Granada.

Day 7 Wednesday, October 21, 2026: Seville, Cooking Class (B, D)

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Visit to **Córdoba:**
 - **Great Mosque of Córdoba:** A UNESCO landmark with iconic red-and-white arches, blending Islamic and Christian design.
 - **Jewish Quarter:** Narrow lanes and whitewashed houses reflecting the city's multicultural past.
- **Seville City Tour:** Continue to Seville for a sightseeing tour featuring the *Santa Cruz* neighborhood, the Royal Alcazar, and the cathedral.
- Check in to the hotel.
- **Tapas dinner** and overnight in **Seville: Hotel Hesperia Sevilla or similar.**

Day 8 Thursday, October 22, 2026: Jerez de la Frontera (B, D)

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- **Excursion to Jerez de la Frontera:** Famous for its sherry wines, equestrian traditions, and Andalusian charm.
- **Visit to Wine Cellar with Tasting:** Guided tour through historic bodegas, learning about the art of sherry-making while sampling signature varieties.
- **Visit to Royal Andalusian School of Equestrian Art:** Watch skilled riders and Andalusian horses perform classical dressage, a tradition celebrated worldwide.
- **Guadalquivir River Cruise:** Scenic boat ride offering views of Seville's landmarks and riverside charm.
- **Farewell Dinner:** Final evening together at a local restaurant.
