## Day 3 Saturday, October 17, 2026: Madrid, Wine Tasting (B)


- Breakfast at the hotel.

### Day 7 Wednesday, October 21, 2026: Seville, Cooking Class (B, D)

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Visit to Córdoba:
  - Great Mosque of Córdoba: A UNESCO landmark with iconic red-and-white arches, blending Islamic and Christian design.
  - Jewish Quarter: Narrow lanes and whitewashed houses reflecting the city's multicultural past.
- **Seville City Tour**: Continue to Seville for a sightseeing tour featuring the *Santa Cruz* neighborhood, the Royal Alcazar, and the cathedral.
- Check in to the hotel.
- Tapas dinner and overnight in Seville: Hotel Hesperia Sevilla or similar

### Day 8 Thursday, October 22, 2026: Jerez de la Frontera (B, D)

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Excursion to Jerez de la Frontera: Famous for its sherry wines, equestrian traditions, and Andalusian charm.
- Visit to Wine Cellar with Tasting: Guided tour through historic bodegas, learning about the art of sherry-making while sampling signature varieties.
- Visit to Royal Andalusian School of Equestrian Art: Watch skilled riders and Andalusian horses perform classical dressage, a tradition celebrated worldwide.
- Guadalquivir River Cruise: Scenic boat ride offering views of Seville's landmarks and riverside charm.
