

Vaccine Guide – Holy Cross



Holy Cross members, your medical plans include coverage of many routine vaccines, including flu shots, COVID-19 vaccines, and also RSV vaccines at \$0. While these vaccines are widely recommended, you should always consult with your physician about your specific needs.

Flu shots

Every year millions of people get the flu. Most people who get the flu have a mild illness, but for some, it can lead to serious health problems. The flu is caused by influenza viruses that affect the lungs, throat and nose, and is highly contagious. According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), getting the yearly flu vaccine is the best way to protect yourself from the flu. The CDC recommends a yearly **flu vaccine** for everyone 6 months of age and older.

Routine vaccines

Other Vaccines help protect you from serious infectious diseases throughout your life—from infancy to early adulthood and into old age. The list of routine vaccines on page 2 are recommended by the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP). This is a federal committee comprised of immunization experts that is convened by the CDC. Routine vaccines are covered on the Holy Cross medical plans and can help you and your family stay healthy.

Schedule your vaccine today

You can schedule a flu shot or a routine vaccine at a network pharmacy. Go to **optumrx.com** and search for a retail pharmacy nearest you.

Many vaccines are available on a walk-in basis.

Show your HPHC/OptumRx ID card before getting your flu shot or vaccine. The Holy Cross medical plans cover certain routine vaccines at 100% when you use network pharmacies.

Talk to your doctor about the specific needs of you and your family. Here is a list of flu shots and CDC-recommended routine vaccines.

Age restrictions or limitations may apply. Check with your network pharmacy for requirements.
