Over 100 students participate in summer research each year

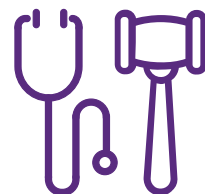

A top producer of Fulbright students during the 2022-23 academic year, according to The Chronicle of Higher Education

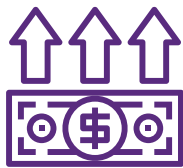


91% of respondents to our survey of the Class of 2022 reported being employed in a job or internship, in graduate school, engaged in service work, or on a fellowship seven months after graduation
