A top producer of Fulbright students during the 2019-20 academic year, according to The Chronicle of Higher Education

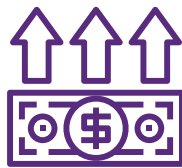


93% of respondents to our survey of the Class of 2019 reported being employed in a job or internship, in graduate school, engaged in service work, or on a fellowship seven months after graduation

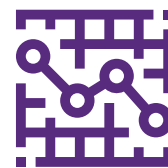
DEBT AND LOAN REPAYMENT
