Biography/History:

Joseph Connors was born on March 15, 1898 in Fall River, MA. He entered the Society of Jesus on August 14, 1918, and was ordained on June 16, 1931. He attended Holy Cross from 1916 to 1918, returning to teach English, Rhetoric and Religion in 1932. He taught for thirty-two years at Holy Cross except while he served as an Air Force Chaplain from 1944 to 1946. He died on October 24, 1970.

Scope and Content Note:

This collection contains the personal correspondence and records of Rev. Connors from the 1930s through the 1960s. The majority of the material is speeches and sermons that he gave while at Holy Cross. The material is both type-written and hand-written. There are also undated, unnamed photographs in this collection.
