Biography/History:

Rev. George A. Costello was born in Lowell, MA in 1890 and attended high school there. He graduated from Holy Cross in 1890 and studied for the priesthood in Brighton, MA. He was the rector of St. Bridget's parish in Lexington, MA at the time of his death. He died on September 27th 1915.

Scope and Content Note:

This collection consists of one box with 72 handwritten sermons identified as written by Rev. Costello, 1895-1908. They were found in the treasure room in the library. Some of the sermons are written on Stationary of T. Costello and Co., Lowell, Mass. The library received books and other material from Costello's estate.

Each sermon has a blue cover with a title and a date. The sermons are 4 to 8 pages in length and many corrections, cross-outs and marginal notes. They are arranged chronologically.
