**Biography/History:**

Lawrence Foran was born on June 25, 1897 in Worcester, MA to Thomas and Ellen (Dolan) Foran. He attended St. John's High School in Worcester. He then matriculated to Holy Cross in 1916 and spent two years at the College before joining the Society of Jesus in 1918. He was ordained on June 20, 1932. He taught at Boston College and Canisius College, Buffalo, NY and later, he became a professor at Shadowbrook, in Lenox, MA. He returned to Holy Cross in 1939. He was a professor of Latin, Greek, English and Theology at Holy Cross until 1961. He was moderator of the Catholic Alumni Sodality of Our Lady of Worcester County from 1945 until 1980. Rev. Foran died on August 3, 1984 at the age of 87.

**Scope and Content Note:**

This collection contains Rev. Lawrence Foran's personal diaries, correspondence, papers, poetry, speeches, notebooks and photographs. Foran's notebooks include retreat notes dating from the 1930s. Other items include Rev. Foran's Masters' Thesis, certificates and diplomas.
