Biography/History:

Frederick Gallagher was born on August 5, 1898 in Stamford, CT, a son of Joseph P. and Mary (Birney) Gallagher. He entered the Society of Jesus on July 30, 1917 at St. Andrew-on-Hudson, NY. From 1921 to 1924 he studied Philosophy at Woodstock College in Maryland. He then went on to Weston College to study Theology, where he was ordained on June 18, 1930. He received his A.B. and M.A. degrees from Woodstock College. He taught English at Holy Cross from 1931 to 1933 and from 1939 until his retirement in 1963 with the exception of those years when he served as a Navy Chaplain. He became a Chaplain in 1942 and served for 5 years, reaching the rank of Commander. At Holy Cross he was the moderator of the Holy Cross drama society. He died on May 25, 1964.

Scope and Content Note:
