Biography/History:

John Haran was born on September 9, 1904 in Worcester, MA. He entered the Jesuits on August 22, 1922, and was ordained on June 20, 1934. He died on March 12, 1981. He attended Holy Cross from 1921 to 1922. He then attended St. Andrew-on-Hudson in Poughkeepsie, NY from 1922 to 1926, Weston College from 1931 to 1935 and the Pontifical Gregorian University in Rome, Italy from 1936-1938 from his PH.D and S.TL. Degrees. In 1938 he completed his dissertation: *Dissertatio Ad Lauream, In Facultate Theologica*. While at Holy Cross he was chairman of the Theology Department from 1949 to 1958. He also worked with the Industrial Relations School from 1952-1956. In 1951 Rev. Haran was the Director of the Institute on Religion.

Scope and Content Note:

This collection consists of two boxes of correspondence, both professional and personal. In addition, his dissertation, some writings, class notes, and jubilee items are included in the files.
