**Biography/History:**

Rev. Lionel P. Honoré, S.J. (1934-2006) was born in New Orleans on December 20, 1934. He attended Xavier University, New Orleans graduating in 1956. He then earned a master's degree in French from Wisconsin University in 1957. A year later, Rev. Honoré entered the Society of Jesus at St. Charles College in Grand Coteau, LA. He studied philosophy at Spring Hill College and then taught at Jesuit High School in El Paso, TX. He finished his theological studies at the Weston school of Theology in 1968 and was ordained the same year, taking his final vows in 1978. In 1973 he obtained a Ph. D. from New York University in Romance Languages and taught at Loyola University, New Orleans. Rev. Honoré came to Holy Cross in 1975 and continued to teach at the college until 2005. While at Holy Cross, Rev. Honoré taught French, Italian and Spanish courses. Rev. Lionel Honoré died on June 25, 2006.

**Scope and Content Note:**

The collection contains correspondence of Honoré concerning publishing of his articles and his work at Holy Cross. There are also personal certificates awarded to Rev. Honoré as well as copies of all his published works. There is also a folder containing biographical information and documents from his funeral service. The collection also contains a bound copy of Rev. Honoré's doctoral dissertation, two medal papal seals and a cloth depicting Christ being taken off the cross with Cyrillic writing around the image.
