Biography/History:

William P. Kennedy was born on October 8, 1877 at Lake City Minnesota. He moved to Massachusetts, where he graduated from College of the Holy Cross in 1900. He received an honorary degree from Holy Cross of Doctor of Literature in 1925 for his achievements as a writer. Kennedy worked for many New England newspapers, including the Springfield Union, the New Haven Palladium, Boston Traveler, Boston Herald, and the Holyoke Evening Telegram, at the last of which he became managing editor. Kennedy spent most of his career working for publications in Washington D.C., where he became a familiar figure on the political scene. He is most noted for his work at The Star, where he was the Capitol Hill reporter where he covered the House of Representatives.
