Scope and Content Note:

The collection contains 4 log books from different ships that sailed on the Atlantic Ocean. The first log book covers the journey of the Brig Meridian from Havana, Cuba to St. Petersburg, Russia and from St. Petersburg to Boston in 1834. The second log book covers the voyage of the Brig Tigris from Gloucester, MA to Gibraltar and Malaga, Spain. The log also covers the journey from Gibraltar to New Orleans, then from New Orleans to Boston in the years of 1835 and 1836. The third log book covers the multiple voyages of the Brig Margret from Boston to Mobile, AL and then back to Wareham, MA between the years 1835 and 1837. The fourth log book covers several journeys of the Brig Shamrock from Boston to Surinam in South America and one voyage from Portland, ME to Havana Cuba then back to Boston in 1836.
