Rev. John McLaughlin, S.J. was born in Providence Rhode Island. He studied at Boston College and was ordained in 1959. He studied at Stanford University and was awarded a Ph.D. from Columbia University. In 1970 he ran for the U.S. senate for Rhode Island, but lost the election. He then became a speech writer for President Richard Nixon. McLaughlin left the Jesuits in 1975.
