Biography/History:

Rev. Clarence Sloane, S.J. was born and raised in Spencer, MA, graduating from Holy Cross in 1918. He joined the Society of Jesus and continued his education at Woodstock College, MD and Weston College. Ordained in 1930, Reverend Sloane, S.J. taught in the departments of Classics, Philosophy, and Psychology at the College of the Holy Cross. Rev. Sloane, S.J. became the college's librarian during his later years following his appointment as head librarian in April, 1942. Rev. Sloane, S.J. died on Dec. 22, 1952.
