H. Martin Williams was born on August 7th, 1840 in Knox County, Ohio. A school teacher from the age of seventeen, he later became a lawyer and actively involved in politics. A Democrat, Williams was a supporter of the single tax movement in his home state of Missouri and took part in the first Single Tax conference in New York City in 1890.
