Gordon Winslow, (?-1964), was born in Putnam, CT and attended Putnam High School. He graduated from Holy Cross in 1933 and was a star on the varsity track team. He was a member of Cargill Council, Knights of Columbus, and Holy Name Society of St. Mary's Church in Putnam. He served in Connecticut National Guard and was elected alderman of Putnam, CT. He married Aline Salvas and had two sons.

Scope and Content Note:

The collection contains 6 folders dating from 1929-1933. The first folder has undated photographs of different buildings and fields on the Holy Cross campus. The second includes group photos of students and faculty dating around 1933. The third folder contains portraits of classmates of Winslow, which they seem to have given him. The fourth folder holds 3 booklets, one is the Crusader Council from 1929-1932 and the other two are the same copy of the senior class booklet in 1933. The fifth folder contains miscellaneous pamphlets and booklets about dances, plays, dinners, and receptions. The sixth folder includes a series of wedding announcements and other miscellaneous articles.
