Biography/History:

Joseph Marique was born on June 3, 1899 in Brussels, Belgium to Pierre and Miriam (Jalhay) Marique. He graduated from Fordham Preparatory School in 1911 and received his A.B. from Fordham College in 1918. He taught at Regis High School until he entered the Society of Jesus on November 21, 1918 at St. Andrew-on-Hudson. Rev. Marique studied there from 1920-1922, at Weston College from 1922-1923, and at Woodstock College from 1923-1924. Rev. Marique spent his regency at Boston College from 1924-1927, and then studied theology at Valkenburg, Holland from 1927-1931. He was ordained on August 27, 1930. Rev. Marique received his PhD in classics from Johns Hopkins in 1941. Also, he taught at Fordham University from 1939-1951, then taught classics at Boston College from 1951-1954. From 1954 until his death, Rev. Marique was a classics professor at Holy Cross. While at Holy Cross, Rev. Marique founded the scholarly journal "Classical Folia" as well as the Institute for Early Christian Iberian Studies. In 1973 Rev. Marique became a Professor Emeritus. A room in the classics department is dedicated in his honor. He died on April 9, 1979.

Scope and Content Note:

This collection includes Fr. Marique's correspondence dating from the 1930s through the 1970s. It contains Fr. Marique's documentation of "Classical Folia" and the Leaders of Iberian Christianity. The third box includes correspondence addressed to Fr. Marique, organized alphabetically. Additionally, this collection holds a number of Fr. Marique's personal effects, such as his Daily Missal. Lastly, the collection has an oversized certificate of Fr. Marique written in Latin. The title is "Opus Fundatum Latinitas."
